# **Confidential Counselling Support Service**

The journey through Fertility Treatment can prove a lengthy and sometimes difficult experience, at a time when couples are already feeling emotionally under strain. The Counselling service is available at any stage whilst you are a patient under our care.

You may find it helpful to talk in a non-medical way with our counsellor. This will give you an opportunity to 'air & share'; to face your hopes, concerns and fears and prepare you both for what is ahead during treatment or tests. Any medical matters or problems should be discussed with the nursing, scientific or medical staff.

The counsellor will provide a safe space in which you can explore the stresses you are experiencing and help you to find ways of managing this more easily.

For couples, counselling sessions enable you to say those things to each other, in a supportive setting that you may not have had the chance to do. They can also strengthen that 'team approach', which is so necessary at this time. You may have counselling individually as well if you would like to explore issues and feelings in your own space.

Patients considering using donated sperm or eggs as part of their treatment are required by the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (HFEA) regulations to have implications counselling before treatment. The support offered is helpful in considering the wider social, emotional and legal implications of these treatments.

Our counsellor, Julie Reiling, is a senior accredited member of the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP) and is also accredited with the British Infertility Counsellors Association (BICA). Julie has many years of experience in the fields of reproductive medicine and counselling. Appointments are normally available during office hours on a Tuesday and a Friday and on a Wednesday evening. Video and telephone appointments are available for any of these sessions and face to face appointments can be offered on Tuesday and Fridays.

Counselling is available free for patients having NHS funded treatment. If you are paying for your own treatment your package includes up to three support counselling sessions if you want them. If you want to continue with counselling after the three appointments there is a charge of £50 per session.

Implications counselling is compulsory for those having treatment using donated sperm or donated eggs and is always chargeable. The cost of implications counselling is £60.
